Notably, four of the top ten works sold came from the Archive of Edition Schellmann, with Keith Haring's iconic *Totem* taking the lead. We are particularly pleased with the strong results achieved for iconic and rare to market works by Andy Warhol as well as innovative, boundary-pushing editions by Ed Ruscha, Donald Judd, and Daniel Buren. Phillips continues to redefine the Editions category, and we are thrilled to have begun 2024 on a high note.
