Elizabeth Goldberg Appointed Senior International Specialist of American Art and Deputy Chairman, Americas

Considered a Leading Authority on American Art, Ms. Goldberg Will Start in July

Before joining Sotheby’s, she was Vice President and Head of American Paintings, Drawings and Sculpture at Christie’s in Los Angeles.

“Attracting Elizabeth to Phillips is a major coup for us,” said Edward Dolman, Chief Executive Officer. “As the foremost authority on American Art in the auction world, she will help us expand our reach in American Art, an increasingly important focus for our company as we expand our offerings further back in the 20th century.
