New York – November 15, 2012 – In a week of billion dollar art sales, Phillips de Pury & Company's Contemporary Art Evening Auction totaled \$79,904,500 selling 83% by lot and 98% by value.

Jean-Michel Basquiat's *Self-Portrait*, 1982, a stunning work-on-paper, sold for \$4,058,500 and achieved the world record for a Basquiat work-on-paper. Paintings by Tauba Auerbach, Rashid Johnson and Sterling Ruby achieved record prices, along with Dan Colen's chewing gum on canvas piece, *S & M*, 2010.
