# Phillips, The Worldwide Leader in Watch Auctions, Achieves

# HK\$110.3 Million During The Hong Kong Watch Auction: SEVEN

# Concluding the Annual Total of Watch Auctions in Asia with a Total of HK\$235 Million / US\$30 Million

HONG KONG – 27 November 2018 – Phillips, in Association with Bacs & Russo, achieved HK\$110.3 million / US\$14 million during The Hong Kong Watch Auction: SEVEN – remaining the number one destination for collectors worldwide by bringing the combined total achieved thus far this fall to US\$35.3 million, which includes our recent auction in Geneva. In this tightly curated sale, a total of 241 collectible timepieces of the highest quality attracted collectors from 50 countries across six continents, including a record number of over 510 online bidders. Particularly strong results were achieved for vintage wristwatches, and antique pocket watches such as the Patek Philippe pocket watch with tourbillon, recipient of the first class prize at the Geneva 1929 Observatory timing competition.

Thomas Perazzi, Head of Watches, Asia, and Auctioneer, said: "As Phillips continues to expand its presence in Asia and offer best-in-class quality, service and passionate scholarship to collectors in the region, this season we saw astonish international participation, with collectors bidding from across six continents, resulting in extraordinary results across the board. The community of watch collectors in Asia showed particularly fierce competition for vintage wristwatches, demonstrating a growing interest in this field. In a crowded room, with an unprecedented number of online, telephone and room bidders, numerous watches soared above their high estimates, setting many exceptional prices."

Aurel Bacs, Senior Consultant and Auctioneer, said: "Following our blockbuster sales in Geneva, the Hong Kong Watch Auction: SEVEN achieved an impressive HK\$110.3 million / US\$14 million. The three top lots beautifully demonstrate how varied the market is, and how well Phillips responds to such a market – with the antique Patek Philippe pocket watch tripling its estimate, modern limited wristwatches by Patek Philippe igniting fierce competition, and the fresh to market Paul Newman Ref. 6241 flying way above its pre-sale low estimate. In this passionate and international marketplace, collectors reacted enthusiastically, resulting in an outstanding sold rate of 93% by lot. We are now very much looking forward to our December 5th New York auction entitled 'STYLED. Timeless Watches & How to Wear Them', a unique and groundbreaking partnership with Mr Porter and The Rake."
