Thought out as a stage set, it represented and celebrated Ponti's unique approach to design and incorporated some of the most iconic and sought after designs from the architect. These outstanding prices were achieved as a result of truly international bidding from some of the most established private collectors of 20th Century Italian Art and Design, for which Phillips continues to be at the forefront of the market."
