Our highly successful collaboration with Calvin Klein resulted in a new world auction record for Steven Meisel, beating Phillips’ previous record, as well as stellar results for Bruce Weber and David Sims. Debuting at auction was 28-year-old Danila Tkachenko, with his unique triptych from *Restricted Areas*, 2013-2015, far exceeding the high estimate.”

Phillips looks forward to concluding the Fall sale season with *Henri Cartier-Bresson: The Eye of the Century*, personal photographs from the collection of his last dealer, Peter Fetterman, in New York on 12 December 2017. Highlights will tour to Phillips Paris, and will be on view to the public at 46 rue du Bac, Paris from 7 to 17 November 2017.
